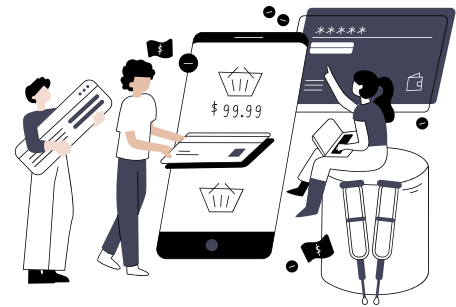

Personalised e-Business Coaching for Construction SMEs

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In the wider construction industry, e-commerce is mainly used by large companies and its true potential is perhaps largely ignored by the smaller companies in the sector. Our aim is to understand why this is the case and to improve the situation by giving small and medium companies in the construction sector the tools to take advantage of e-commerce. PEACOC will develop a training programme tailored to the ECVET profile of the e-business manager in the construction sector.



Aims of the project

PEACOC aims to **increase the cross-border activities of SMEs in the construction sector** so that they do not have to constantly compete in the same market for the same customers but are able to reach larger markets and attract customers through competitive pricing. Therefore, PEACOC promotes the development of the construction sector at the national level and has a positive impact on job creation and economic activity.

Impact of the project

- Small and medium companies in the construction sector will increase their online sales, improve their performance and reduce their operating costs, thus **becoming more competitive**.
- VET Trainers, e-business coaches, salespeople, and business development staff in the construction sector will **improve their knowledge and skills, acquire new skills** and continue their personal or professional development.

The objective of the PEACOC project is to design, develop, test, implement and disseminate an innovative **e-Business Manager Training** course for small and medium-sized enterprises in the construction sector, based on the needs and specificities of this economic sector. Module 1: E-business in construction is inevitable in the long run and brings competitive advantages. This module will help to increase productivity and explain terms you should be familiar with when entering e-business.

Module 2: Digital transformation means digitising business activities, and with this module, you will learn some measures to support the transition, especially in relation to suppliers, customers, and HRM.

Module 3: Project management helps every part of the business run more smoothly. It allows a business to focus on the work that matters, free from distractions, without tasks getting out of hand or budgets going out of control. In this module, you will learn about needs and context analysis, project planning, day-to-day management, and review and reporting.

Module 4: The role and benefits of **collaboration platforms** are that all stakeholders have access to the same information. In this module, you will learn how to identify collaboration platforms and shared data environments, set up platforms, and use a predefined CDE.

Module 7: E-procurement is the requesting, ordering, buying, and selling of supplies, products, and services over the internet and enables companies to automate business processes. The module teaches the benefits of e-procurement, its terms, and an overview of public e-procurement web platforms.

Module 8: Many problems in business arise from ineffectively managed **supply chains**, particularly in the construction sector. The aim of this module is to help SMEs in the construction sector make their supply chains more efficient and functional by digitising them and bringing some of the key functions online.

Module 9: Digital marketing allows you to communicate with your customers in real-time and they can communicate with you. The aim of this module is to present guidelines for creating a marketing plan, digital advertising, building a good network of contacts, and creating multimedia content to build a brand identity.
