1 Introduction & objectives of the Multiplier Event

The Multiplier Event was organized by Itecons at its facilities that are located in Coimbra, Portugal, on the 3rd of November 2022, with a total of 21 participants. Other 12 participants from different research areas at Itecons decided to join the event.

In this Multiplier Event, the different outputs developed throughout the PEACOC project were presented. The main challenges inherent to the digitalisation process of SMEs in the construction sector were also debated. Thus, the theme of the event was "Strategies for the Digital Transformation of SMEs of the Construction Sector".

2 Agenda

The event was conducted by Professor Julieta António, PhD graduates of University of Coimbra and member of the Board of Directors at Itecons. She is also the Coordinator of the Training and Events Unit at Itecons and one of the Itecons team members involved in the PEACOC project.

Focused on the digital transformation of SMEs of the construction sector, different speakers were invited to participate on the event:

- Michael Brett is a Mechanical engineer and works in the Special work division under the Measurement and testing unit at Itecons. He is also involved in the DIGITALbuilt initiative, that has been recognized as a European Digital Innovation Hub for the Initial Network of European Digital Innovation Hubs;
- Andreia Gil is the executive coordinator of the technical assessment unit at Itecons.
 She is also involved in several projects regarding CE Marking for construction products;
- Mafalda Cardoso is the executive coordinator of the Quality, Safety and Environmental Managment at Itecons and has been involved in a project regarding the development of a tool for SMEs digitalization (DREAM project);
- Beatriz Marques is one of the Itecons team members involved in the PEACOC project and presented the main goals and outputs of the project.

At the end of the event, there was a discussion where some distinguished guests were invited to speak about the importance of digitalisation and digital transformation of SMEs of the construction sector. This moment was conducted by Professor António Tadeu, president of the Board of Directors at Itecons and one of the Itecons team members involved in the PEACOC project. 3 Promotional activities

The Multiplier Event was promoted through our social networks (LinkedIn, Instagam and Facebook) and our newsletter (to reach clients, partners and associates). Additionally, local newspapers were also asked to help promoting this event and reaching our target groups from the construction sector: suppliers, manufacturers, designers, consultants, researchers and professional associations.

4 Event

The Multiplier event took place in Itecons. The speakers were invited to prepare different presentations to support the reflection and discussion on the theme of the event. To this end, the PEACOC powerpoint template was used for all presentations.

The participants were reunited at the auditorium, where the presentations would take place. The event was conducted physically and in Portuguese.

The event started with an opening session, where Julieta António reminded the agenda for the session and the goal of the event.

The presentations began with a reflection on the importance of digitalisation in the construction sector, conducted by Michael Brett. This presentation was the opportunity to introduce the importance of digitalisation and digital transformation on different economic areas and specially for the construction sector.



Next, Andreia Gil continued with a presentation with the title "Quality in SME Process Management". This presentation presented an occasion to introduce the complexity of process management and quality issues for SMEs, as this digital transformation can also be an opportunity to improve these aspects on these companies.



The session continued with the presentation "Digitalisation: challenges, opportunities and best practices" conducted by Mafalda Cardoso. The speaker selected some examples of successful implementations of digitalisation in SMEs and also some challenges that must be taken into account throughout this process. This presentation was the kick-off for the coffee-break, where some experiences were shared by the participants.



After the coffee-break, the Multiplier event continued with a presentation of the PEACOC project by Beatriz Marques, one of the Itecons team members involved in this project.







5.2 Feedback evaluation

The feedback evaluation was conducted by creating an online survey with 8 questions with a 4-point Likert scale, with 1 being "very weak" and 5 being "very good". The survey was prepared in portuguese and sent by e-mail to all participants after the event. A total of 13 participants responded to the survey. It is important to highlight that this survey was only sent to participants who do not belong to Itecons, in order to guarantee unbiased opinions about the event.

The first questions were aimed to evaluate the general organisation of the event:






According to the responses, all the participants had an excellent impression from the event, marking the options between "good" and "very good".

The following question was focused on the speakers and their presentations, where most participants considered they were "very good":


Qual foi a sua opinião em relação aos oradores e às apresentações? 13 respostas

O que achou do local do evento?



Next, the participants were asked if they think that the event informed adequately on PEACOC materials for e-business development:




Despite the general opinion, one participant didn't think that event informed adequately on PEACOC materials. This opinion could be related to the reduced time for this presentation. At the same time, most comments and questions made by participants were focused on other issues regarding digitalisation of SMEs of the construction sector, namely financial incentives and bureaucracy, whish reduced the time available to discuss PEACOC tools.

Next, the participants were asked if they believed they would you make use of the e-Business Training Course, Genie and Retention Service produced to develop and validate your e-business competencies:

Most participants replied that they would make uses of the PEACOC tools. However, one participant did not have a clear opinion and another participant did not show interest to use the PEACOC tools in the future.

The final questions were open to written replies on what part of the event was most and least liked, and additional comments.

Regarding the most liked aspects:

- "Discussion group";
- "From the discussion group, I liked the speakers' speech";
- "Presentations and debate (discussion group)";
- "Discussion group and PEACOC tools";
- "From the discussion group";
- The PEACOC tool presentation, as it was very dynamic";
- "Discussion group";
- "The presentation of the PEACOC tool because of its usefulness";
- "Mainly from the examples given by the guests";
- · "The exchange of experiences";
- · "Discussion group";
- · "Presentation about PEACOC".

Regarding the least liked:

- · "Maybe from the little sharing of experiences by the public because they were shy at the beginning, but it's nothing that depended on the organization. After the organisation stimulated participation, it got better";
- "Initial presentations"

In the end, there were no suggestions.

6 Conclusions

Along the sessions of the Multiplier event, the organization received positive feedback from both the project and the event. Most participants shared common concerns regarding digitalisation process of SME's, while facing other relevants challenges, such as sustainability and economic crisis.

In the end, all expressed their gratitude for this opportunity to discuss these topics.
